11. Evaluate and integrate modern solutions like API gateways and B2B portals with legacy EDI.
12. Ensure seamless integration of EDI with the ERP's finance and accounts payable/receivable modules.
13. Calculate the ROI and implement strategies for operational cost reduction through EDI automation.

- Leveraging cloud-based iPaaS for flexible connectivity and scalability.
- Case Study: A large manufacturer's phased rollout of a Supplier Portal to onboard small-to-medium enterprise (SME) suppliers quickly.

Module 5: Secure Communication and Protocol Management

- Case Study: Post-implementation review of a multi-year EDI program, focusing on achieving sustained high ROI and user adoption.
