- Administering vasoactive medications
- Case Study: Hypovolemic shock in a cat

Module 6: Sepsis & Multi-Organ Failure

- Early recognition of sepsis
- Supportive care and organ monitoring
- Antimicrobial stewardship in critical care
- Nutritional support in critical patients
- Case Study: Septicemia in a post-surgical dog

Module 7: Surgical & Anesthesia Emergencies

- Emergency surgical interventions
- Safe anesthesia protocols for unstable patients
- Post-operative monitoring and critical care
- Pain management strategies
- Case Study: Emergency splenectomy in a dog with hemoperitoneum

Module 8: Advanced Monitoring & ICU Care

- ICU workflow and nursing care protocols
- Use of advanced diagnostic tools in ICU

- Case Study: Multi-day ICU management of a cat with pancreatitis
